Home School Learning

In line with government guidance, we will continue to provide Home School Learning for children who are unable to attend school. Our On-Line Learning Platform will continue to be developed as the year progresses and the staff will of course keep you fully informed as to the work they are setting for your child. Next week there will be a designated tab on the school website to keep everyone informed of future developments.

If your child is not in school and is well enough to engage in Home School Learning please:

1. Under the **Pupil Tab**, select **Lessons**.

This will take you to the **On-Line Classroom**.

2. Select **Schedule**
3. Select **Year Group**

This will provide you with a daily age appropriate **English and Mathematics lesson and at least one Foundation Subject**. If the lessons prove too difficult, select the previous year group. If on the other hand the lesson is too easy, select the next Year Group up. The schedule changes at midnight daily.

In addition to this schedule, individual class teachers will contact you either via Google (Junior School) or Class DoJo (Infant School) to provide additional learning activities as appropriate.

Whilst your child is absent, health permitting, please also ensure that your child practices daily:

- Reading
- Tables/Number Bonds.
- Weekly Spellings.

As was the case during lockdown, we recognise the added pressure Home School Learning can bring to you as parents, particularly on those who have to balance Home School Learning with working from home. All we ask is that your child does his/her best to complete the set work whilst they are off and we will address any learning difficulties when they return. You can of course make contact via Class DoJo if you need any advice or support whilst your child is absent.
